Secure administrative support

Identify your waste



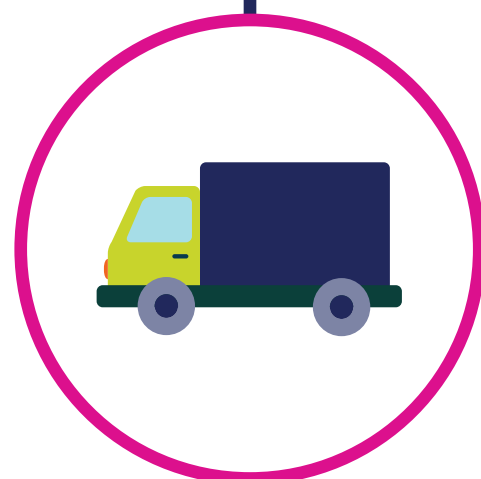

Create a waste system



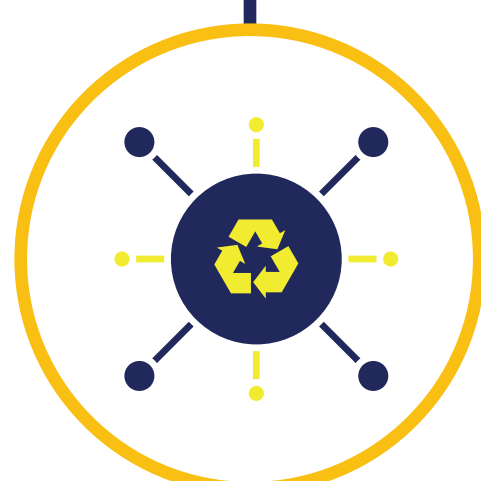
Purchase colour-coded bins and signage to support the bin system, ensuring students and staff separate recyclables from waste. Store recyclables in a secure location while prioritising health and safety.

Disposal of waste



For the collection and transportation of waste and recyclables, consider the volume of waste generated. Choose an efficient disposal option such as a municipal or a private collection service.

Develop a communication, educational plan



To ensure long-term engagement with the initiative, monitor the program, and identify where improvements can be made. Create awareness and conduct collection and recycling workshops.
